<u>Information Collection</u>: This Policy applies to information we collect to provide our services,

including information obtained or provided:

directly from browsing or interacting with our Website;

in email, text, and other electronic messages between you and the Company;

through mobile and/or desktop applications available from the Company;

upon submission by you to the Company; or

created when you visit our Website, such as device information and communications

data.

The Policy does not apply to information collected by the Company offline or through any other

means, including on any other website operated by Company or any third party (including our

affiliates and subsidiaries).

Our Website is not intended for children under 13 years of age and we do not knowingly collect

personal information from children under 13. By continuing to use this Website, you confirm

that you are at least 13 years of age. If we learn we have collected or received personal

Use of Information We Collect: We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

<u>Disclosure and Sharing of Your Information</u>: We may disclose aggregated information about our users, without restriction. In addition, We may disclose information that we collect or you provide as described in this Policy:

- to our subsidiaries and affiliates, including Biomarine, Inc.;
- to contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support the Company;
- to a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of the Company's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which information held by the Company about our Website users is among the assets transferred;
- to fulfill the purpose for which you provide the information;
- to the general public, when you submit content to a public forum such as blogs, social media, and other features of our Website;
- for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information; and/or
- with your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- to comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

Where We Store Your Information: Some companies that provide services to us run their services from outside the USA. We only let that happen if we are satisfied with their levels of security. Keep in mind that when you give us personal information it could be being transferred, stored or processed in a location outside the USA.

<u>Data Retention and Erasure</u>: We generally retain your personal information for as long as is necessary for the uses described in this Policy and to comply with our legal obligations. In certain jurisdictions, you can request to have all your personal information deleted.
